Cemetery Fees Effective 1 November 2024

Purchase of Plot / Interment

	Resident	Non-Resident
Purchase of New Burial Plot	£1,500.00	£3,000.00
Interment in Full Burial Plot (1 x Casket / 1 x Remains)*	£800.00	£1,600.00
Purchase of New Cremated Remains Plot	£500.00	£1,000.00
Internment of ashes in Cremated Remains Plot	£250.00	£500.00
Exclusive Right of Burial Deed	£50.00	£50.00

Please note a re-opening of a plot incurs interment cost only, provided that Exclusive Right of Burial Deed is dated within the period of time granted at the time the plot was purchased.

*The fee for a simultaneous double burial of two non-residents in a full-sized plot in the same casket is reduced to £2,100.00. This fee consists of £1,600.00 for the first non-resident burial in a full-size plot (irrespective of casket size), and an additional £500.00 supplement for the cremated remains of a second non-resident to be included in the same casket. If the second remains belong to those of a resident, then this fee is reduced to £250.00. The additional £500.00/£250.00 applies only in circumstances where the cremated remains of a second loved one are to be interred in the same casket, with the policy limiting this to only one further set of cremated remains (in addition to the first loved one being buried at the same time).

Similarly, for residents, this new fee structure will incur a cost of £800.00 for the first resident burial in a full-size plot (irrespective of casket size), and an additional £250.00 supplement for the cremated remains of a second resident to be included in the same casket. If the second remains are of those of a non-resident, then the £500.00 fee would apply. For individual burials of a resident in a full size plot, the fee remains at £800.00, regardless of whether the burial involves a full body casket or a cremated remains casket. The additional £250.00 applies only in circumstances where the cremated remains of a second resident are to be interred in the same casket, with the policy limiting this to only one further set of cremated remains (in addition to the first loved one being buried at the same time).
