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Minutes of the Full Council Meeting of Kingsley Parish Council held at 7:00pm on 16 June 2026 at Kingsley Community Centre, 34 Smithy Lane, Kingsley, Frodsham, WA6 8ED.

Minute 2627.018	Apologies The Council noted the apologies received from Cllrs Moores and Vernon.
Minute 2627.019	Declarations None.
Minute 2627.020	Minutes The Council accepted the minutes of the last meeting.
Minute 2627.021	Public Participation None.
Minute 2627.022	Planning The Council considered recent planning applications. The Council resolved to support (in principle) planning application 26/01291/FUL (Cafe) with due consideration to be given to parking, neighbour disturbance, amenity space, and waste storage. The Council resolved not to object to 26/01678/FUL (Sunnyhurst House) with due consideration given to the Supplementary Planning Guidance.
Minute 2627.023	Neighbourhood Plan Members considered the merits of a Kingsley Neighbourhood Plan, and reflected on the efforts made by prior council administrations. Members agreed a community survey would be the best forum to establish if interest exists in the village for this to be revisited.
Minute 2627.024	Finance The Council considered and unanimously agreed the FY2526 annual accounts, Section 1 of the AGAR, and Section 2 of the AGAR.

Minute 2627.025	Playing Field Members requested that grass cutting, where possible, not be undertaken on a Saturday. Members noted ongoing projects included the pathway lip, wildflower meadows and the rewilding area.
Minute 2627.026	Village Projects The Council noted the update regarding the EOI process for Middle Lane Playing Field and agreed the submission to CWaC. Members noted that quotes would need to be obtained for the revised drawing of the Co-Op ramp. Members received an update regarding the village enhancement schedule.
Minute 2627.027	Highways Members agreed that liaison with CWaC and Cllr Deynem may be required to assist with Mille Lane and Meeting House Lane.
Minute 2627.028	Cemetery The Council reviewed its Cemetery Fee schedule and unanimously agreed to accept it without any amends.
Minute 2627.029	Chairman's Report The Chairman noted that the large tree that has been removed from the church will be replaced with a new tree.
